Technical committees on power electronics and electric machines/drives within IES have assigned judges from industry/academia to participate in the final testing of the prototypes.


There will be two separate awards for innovation in power electronic design and control of electric drives.

The recipients of these awards will be invited to attend the IECON 2011 (Australia) and receive their awards at the banquet. (Travel expenses for the team representative will be covered.)


The award includes a \$5000.00 cash award along with a certificate.
